MINUTES OF SPAIN MOBILITY

Monday, 18 November

9:00 MEETING AT SCHOOL

Students reception at the gym. Backpacks and material delivery, icebreaker games and dances. We choose a representative and we give them the seven flags.

9:45 WE LEAVE SCHOOL

We pick up the Erasmus teachers at the hotel. We all go to the Town Hall.

10:30 WELCOME AT TORREJÓN TOWN HALL

Reception at the plenary at the plenary hall on the part of the councilor. Brief welcome speech and pictures of the different countries with the councilor, as well as all Erasmus participants of the project.

11:30 WELCOME AT OUR SCHOOL

Younger students are waiting for us making a hallway with flags from all countries. The hallway goes from the entrance to the entrance of the auditorium. The reception is accompanied by music.

In the auditorium welcome speech of the director and the head of studies of the school in Spanish with translation in English.

Shows: Hymn of Joy, a cappella by volunteer students in the 5th and 6th grades, at the piano Jose Luis, the music teacher; Chotis "Madrid, Madrid", danced by volunteer students in the 5th and 6th grades, Pasodoble "Qué viva España", danced by volunteer students in the 5th and 6th grades.

12:15 BREAK

Snack at the library (paella, pastries, empanadas, drinks, coffee, etc.)

12:45 SCHOOL VISIT (Javi, Cristina M., Mary e Inma)

The school spaces are visited, going in some classrooms, in two groups.

13:30 LUNCH AT SCHOOL

The Erasmus students have lunch at the school canteen. Then they have free time at the schoolyard.



15:00 WORKSHOP 1: "I ALREADY KNOW YOU"

In the library, the students see the presentations on the whiteboard (each country will present during about 3 minutes). The 6 mixed groups with which they will work all week are made.

Each group will democratically choose a name for their team (Fireflies, Wild Horses, Rainbow, Erasmus Stars, Supergirls, Dream Team). In the playground: games to meet, presentation and cooperative games.

17.00 FAMILY TIME

Families pick up students.

20:00 WELCOME DINNER INVITATION

Welcome dinner at Tastevin with Erasmus teachers, music and dances.

Tuesday, 19 November:

9:00 MEETING AT SCHOOL

The students come at 9 and we take them to the library.

9:10 POLICE CONFERENCE

Police talk on Cyberbullying.

10:30 WORKSHOP 3: "EMOTIONAL EXPRESSION"

Students are divided into two groups: group A will do the butterfly workshop. Group B will do the t-shirt workshop. 45 minutes per workshop (approx.) and they swap workshops. In these workshops creativity, free expression and cooperative work are promoted by helping each other.

12:00 BREAK

Snack at the library (homemade pizza, churros, pastries, drinks, coffee, etc.)

12:30 WORKSHOP 5: "EMOTIONAL AND SOCIAL INTELLIGENCE"

Laura García, psychopedagogue, explains the students the importance of emotions, positive language, etc. Practical activities are carried out with the students.

13:30 LUNCH AT SCHOOL

The Erasmus students have lunch at the school canteen. Then they have free time at the schoolyard.

15:00 WORKSHOP 2.1.: "EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION"

Watching scenes from the movie "Wonder." Comments on the scenes reflecting on the different attitudes that the characters present and valuing other modes of action.

In groups the students make a DINA 3 poster to prevent bullying or action advice. All members of the team must participate in the poster and collaborate with everyone in its design and implementation.

17.00 FAMILY TIME

Families pick up students.



Wednesday, 20 November

9:00 MEETING AT SCHOOL

Reception of the students in the auditorium and lunch delivery. Brief explanation of the day. Bus.

9:10 MADRID VISIT

The bus leave us at the Royal Palace and we start the cultural visit: Royal Palace, Opera, Almudena Cathedral, Plaza Mayor. At the Plaza Mayor they have some free time to have a snack and take a walk. Each school go together with their teachers. We continue the visit: Puerta del Sol, Congress Palace, Neptuno, Cibeles, Alcalá Gate and Retiro Park. At each point a brief explanation is made.

13:30 LUNCH AT RETIRO'S PARK

Teachers and students have lunch (picnic) at Retiro Park.

14:00 WORKSHOP 2.2.: "EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION"

After having lunch each team has to record a video against bullying. Each group has a tablet. The video has to be one minute and a half maximum. All the students in the team have to take part in the activity. The Erasmus teachers will be in charge of coordinating the teams and help them with the video.

15:00 PRADO MUSEUM VISIT

We have two hours to visit the museum on our own. Each teacher will accompany their students.

17.00 BACK TO SCHOOL

Back to school by bus.

17:30 FAMILY TIME

Families pick up students.

Thursday, 21 November

9:00 MEETING AT SCHOOL

Reception of the students in the auditorium.

9:10 WORKSHOP 6: "GYMKANA AT EUROPE PARK"

We make our way to Europa Park where the gymkhana is going to take place. Each team has to look for the clues around the monuments. The theme of the gymkhana is "Around the World". La Gaviota teachers are characterized and they put obstacles (make up some dance, create an anti-bullying slogan, sing a song...) in order to liven up the tour. A small guided visit is made for the Erasmus teachers.

16:15 WORKSHOP 3: "EMOTIONAL EXPRESSION"

They finish painting the butterflies they made with clay on Tuesday.



13:30 LUNCH AT SCHOOL

The Erasmus students have lunch at the school canteen. They have free time at the schoolyard.

15:00 WORKSHOP 4: "SCAPE ROOM"

Escape-room at the second floor, prepared by a company. They have to solve some clues and open some caskets with locks in order to escape. They have around 60 minutes. The theme is to guess the members of a family. They work in cooperative teams they have made to help each other.

16:30 WORKSHOP 7: "How to create videos"

At the library, the teams edit the videos that they recorded at the Retiro Park against bullying.

17.00 FAMILY TIME

Families pick up students.

Friday, 22 November:

9:00 MEETING AT SCHOOL

Reception of the students in the auditorium and trip by bus to Guernica school in San Fernando de Henares.

9:10 GUERNICA SCHOOL VISIT: WORKSHOP 8: "ANTIBULLYING KIVA METHOD"

Workshop on the KiVa method, which was carried out two years ago.

At 11:30 we come back to school and we take our way to Alcalá.

12:00 WORKSHOP 9: "TREASURE HUNT" IN ALCALÁ DE HENARES

Walk through the center of Alcalá de Henares up to Plaza Cervantes. There they are divided into the 6 teams. A questions game is made around the city. As they respond well to each question at each point, they are given a puzzle piece and a picture is taken with the monuments. In the end, they all build the puzzle with the project logo.

The points are: University of Alcalá, Plaza Cervantes, Cervantes' birthplace, Santos Niños Cathedral, Archbishop's Palace.

14:00 LUNCH AT ALCALA'S UNIVERSITY

Due to the rain the place where we were going to have lunch is changed. Instead of having a picnic at Plaza Cervantes, we go in a classroom at the Philology Faculty, assigned by the University of Alcalá de Henares. At the end they have free time with their teachers to take a walk around the center of Alcalá.

15:30 EVALUATION QUESTIONNAIRE AND PHOTO HUNT

We return to the school and we separate into two groups, each one goes to one of the computer rooms where the Erasmus students do the assessment questionnaire.

16:00 FAMILY TIME

Families pick up students.



17:30 TORREJÓN AT CHRISTMAST TIME

Due to the rain the the Magical Christmas visit is canceled. Each Erasmus student can go with their host family.

20:30 FINAL DINNER

Dinner at the school, sharing our experiences in the school canteen. There is Spanish omelette, paella, gazpacho, burgers, Iberian sausages, snacks, pastries and a commemorative cake with the project logo.

22:30 CLOSING CEREMONY

Delivery of certificates, papers, posters, etc. In the auditorium, we invite each country to pick up their certificates on the stage while the anthem of their country is played.

23:00 PARTY AND KARAOKE

Dancing in the auditorium, attending to the needs of the participants.
