Short term exchange of groups of pupils
ON LINE activities - ROMANIA
MINUTES

Day one: Monday, 10. May. 2021

- Welcoming the participants. The principal of „Liviu Rebreanu „National College gives a speech to the participants.
- **Workshop1: „Disinformation lab”.** Mrs Cristina Lupu, the CEO of the Independent Journalism Institute, in Bucharest, teaches the students how to deal with fake news in digital space and what does a digital footprint mean. The students find out how to deconstruct a message, how to evaluate the source and purpose and what creative techniques can be used to attract attention.
- Short break
- **Workshop 2: „We are butterflies- different but yet the same”.** The representatives in each country(students assisted by their coordinators) reveal their own culture, traditions, habits in order to enhance the level of empathy with the people who are different, establishing an intercultural connection. The students sing and explain the meaning of traditional songs and show intercultural dances and costumes from each partner country.

Day two: Tuesday 11. May. 2021

- **Workshop 3: “Surfing the way- resilience”.** Mrs Laura Souca, school counselor at „Liviu Rebreanu” National College, using e-games, develops the students`capacity to adapt successfully to challenges that threaten their emotional system. Students learn about what resilience is, as a human capacity to adapt to hard/difficult situations and the resilience is useful and what can children do to be resilient. The students understand that they have to keep connected, respect themselves, challenge their minds, look on the bright side, be kind to the others and most of it, to have a goal to follow.
- Short break
- **Workshop 4: „Living in an imperfect peace”.** Within an experiential learning, Mrs Laura Souca leads the children to a better understanding of relationships and wellbeing. The students become aware of the fact that having positive emotions, being engaged in an activity, having good relationships with other people, finding the meaning in their life and a

sense of accomplishment in the pursuit of their goals. All these are transposed into PERMA model (Positive emotions, Relationships, Accomplishment, Engagement, Meaning).

Day three: Wednesday 12. May. 2021

- **Workshop 5: Participative interdisciplinary e-lesson- Cyberbullying.** Mrs Helena Schuster, English teacher at “Liviū Rebreanu” National College, using interactive e-games, challenges the students to take part in a brainstorming to reach the ten golden rules for being cyber smart: block the bully, tell an adult, don't share your password or account, ignore it if it's a first time offence, don't reply, save the evidence, keep a log of everything that happened, report it to the social media site, be careful with strangers, keep private photos private.
- Short break
- **Workshop 6: “Marks of a new century”.** Mrs Petra Baciū, Art teacher at “Liviū Rebreanu” National College, coordinates an experiential learning about globalization, migration, internationalization, and digitalization, in which children find out that colours and paintings can influence the way people transmit or understand a message. They also learn about the meaning of face expressions through pictures. The teacher makes them better understand what the connection between art and the entire world is. Pupils turn digital rocks in gentle ones, filled with anti bullying messages .

Day four: 13. May 2021

- **Workshop 7: “Mock up trial”.** The participants, coordinated by Mrs Alina Cret, educational advisor at “Liviū Rebreanu” National College take part in an experiential learning using a role play held by students who are assisted by teachers and judges. The role play takes place at the Courthouse of Bistrița and reveals a real case of bullying complaint.
- Short break
- **Workshop 8: “This house supports expel of bullying students”- debate.** Starting with the resolution given in the mock up trial, the students, divided in three groups, create a brainstorming with pros and cons reactions. A jamboard is used to write opinions, to debate and vote solutions.

Day five: 14. May.2021

- **Workshop 9: “The voice of students: we are not targets, dear friends!”** It is a remembering where students who have taken part in the project and mobilities express their feelings, experiences and knowledge gathered in a handbook of coexistence in peace, useful both for teachers and parents.

- Sharing results during last week, certificates of attendance for the students.

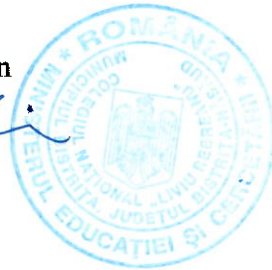
End of the Romanian on-line activities.
